

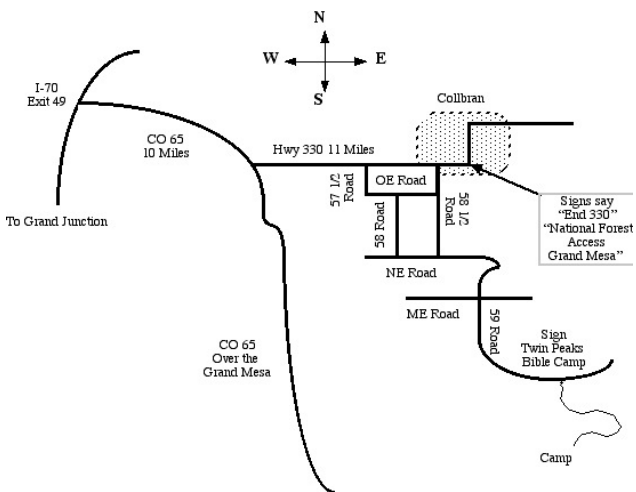

Directions: From I-70

Take I-70 to exit 49 (CO 65, Powderhorn exit) go east on CO 65 (10 Miles) to Highway 330 (watch for Collbran sign) go east on Highway 330 to Collbran (11 miles). As you come into Collbran turn right at the first street, 58 1/2 Road go straight 2 miles and follow signs to Bonham Reservoir. Camp is 7 miles south of Collbran on 59 Road.

From Cedaredge, Delta County

Take CO 65 north through Cedaredge over the Grand Mesa to Highway 330 (watch for Collbran sign) go east on Highway 330 to Collbran (11 miles). As you come into Collbran turn right at the first street, 58 1/2 Road go straight 2 miles and follow signs to Bonham Reservoir. Camp is 7 miles south of Collbran on 59 Road.
