Responsibilities:

Invest in each camper for the week that they are attending. Share the Gospel message with each camper and encourage them to grow in their relationship with Christ. Lead cabin devotions. Provide supervision and care for campers at all times. Help lead games, worship, or other activities that benefit the camper's experience. Be willing to perform cleaning duties. Be willing to serve in any other support role during the summer. Be ready to participate in activities alongside campers. (It can be physically demanding)

Requirements:

Must have graduated high school or be 18 years of age or older. Submit TPBC Staff/ Volunteer Application. Attend Counselor Training Week: June 8-12. Obtain/have a current CPR certification. Will complete the "Standard Precautions" and "Recognizing Child Abuse and Neglect" state training and the CBI, FBI, and Trails background check. Take "Sexual Abuse Awareness" Training and "Peer to Peer Sexual Abuse" training on a staff training day. Sign Staff Contract and Camp/ Staff Policies. Submit a Health Form.

☐ **Summer Staff Leaders (A-Team Leader/ A-Team Chaperones/ Child Care)**

Responsibilities:

Invest in each A Teamer/ Staff Kid for the week they serve. Share the Gospel message with each volunteer and encourage them to grow in their relationship with Christ. Lead

devotions. Provide supervision and care for teen volunteers/ staff kids and ensure tasks are completed entirely and safely. Be ready to lead by example by exhibiting a good work ethic and a love for people.

Requirements:

Must have graduated high school or be 18 years of age or older. Submit TPBC Staff/ Volunteer Application. Attend Counselor Training Week: June 8-12. Obtain/have a current CPR certification. Will complete the "Standard Precautions" and "Recognizing Child Abuse and Neglect" state training and the CBI, FBI, and Trails background check. Take "Sexual Abuse Awareness" Training and "Peer to Peer Sexual Abuse" training on a staff training day. Sign Staff Contract and Camp/ Staff Policies. Submit a Health Form.

☐ **Camp Nurse**

Responsibilities:

Familiarize yourself with the TPBC registration system. Arrive on time and be prepared to check in campers with medications on Mondays. Review the emergency plan. Administer medications as needed and keep detailed records of medical treatments, incident reports, and medicines administered. Be available at all times for camper and staff emergencies. Take inventory of medical supplies at the beginning and end of each week, ensuring that medical packs are well-maintained and adequately supplied. Maintain a clean environment in the Health Center.

Requirements:

Hold current nursing qualifications and current CPR certification. Submit TPBC Staff/ Volunteer Application. Attend a volunteer Training Day: May 2nd or June 13th. Obtain/have a current CPR certification. Will complete "Recognizing Child Abuse and Neglect" state training, and the CBI, FBI, and Trails background check. Take "Sexual Abuse Awareness" Training and "Peer to Peer Sexual Abuse" training on a staff training day. Sign Staff Contract and Camp/ Staff Policies. Submit a Health Form.

☐ **Head Cook/ Kitchen Help**

Responsibilities:

Coordinate with the Kitchen Coordinator to develop the menu and familiarize yourself with the recipes for the week. The Head Cook is responsible for delegating and assigning tasks to kitchen helpers, ensuring that quantities meet the camp's needs, and ensuring food is served on time. The Head Cook must also review all food allergies to provide appropriate meals for those with special dietary requirements. Additionally, coordinate with the Kitchen Coordinator to perform inventory and assist in ordering supplies for the following week. Kitchen helpers are expected to arrive on time and assist the Head Cook as needed while following all safe food handling procedures. Finally, ensure the kitchen and refrigerators are left clean and ready for the next cooking team.

Requirements:

Submit TPBC Staff/ Volunteer Application. Have/ take Food Handlers Training (need certificate). Take "Sexual Abuse Awareness" training on a staff training day. Sign Staff Contract and Camp/ Staff Policies. Submit a Health Form. Applicants must be over 18 for the Head Cook position and over 16 to help in the kitchen. (Applicants under 18 have restrictions on equipment they are allowed to operate.) Have a good attitude and be willing to work with others.
